Submission Guidelines

1. Abstract Requirements

- a. The abstract submitted must be original work.
- b. The abstract should be written in English.
- c. The abstract should include the title, authors' full names (indicating the presenting author), affiliation, keywords and main text.
- d. Individuals and collaborative teams.
- e. The main text should be summarized in separate paragraphs for: introduction, methodology, results, conclusions and topic relevance.
- f. The maximum length of the main text is 350 words (excluding spaces)
- g. The abstract must be submitted as a Microsoft Word document (docx) and NOT as a PDF file.
- h. Page margins must be set as follows: Top = 2.5 cm; Bottom = 2.5 cm; Left = 2.25 cm and Right = 2.0 cm.
- i. Use Times New Roman font for all text, including headings.
- j. Specific instructions:
 - Title: 14 points, bold, sentence case (capitals for proper nouns only).
 - Authors' names: 11 points; initials of the first name should come after the family name for each author; the presenting author should be underlined; use superscript number to indicate different affiliations.
 - Authors' affiliation: 11 points, sentence case (capitals for first letter and proper nouns only); provide email address of the first or presenting author and each affiliation defined by a superscript number.
 - Abstract text: 12 points.

- 4. Responding to the Climate Risks to Heritage and Fostering Culture-Based Climate Action.

Our four topics can be viewed as standalone, but they are also deeply intertwined with one another. The topics may be seen as corollaries complementary to each other. The topics can be considered as widely as possible and are designed in keeping with our mission to encourage ideas about culture for the future.
