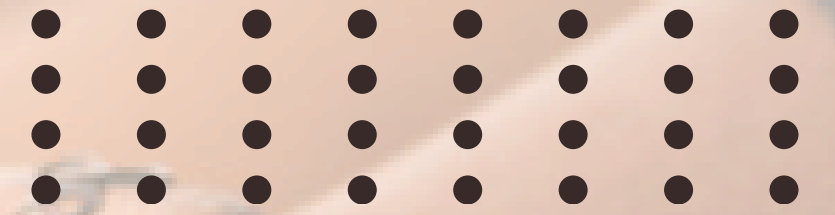


INTRODUCTION

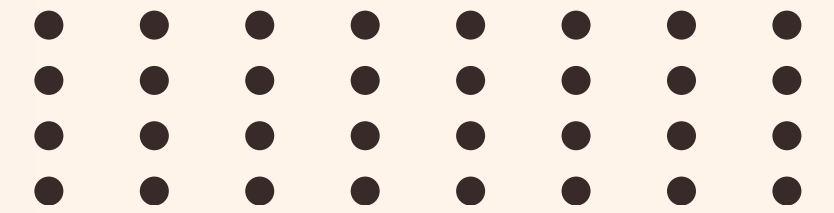
YOUTH AS PARTNERS

"Through poetry, we whisper hope. Through music, we sing unity.

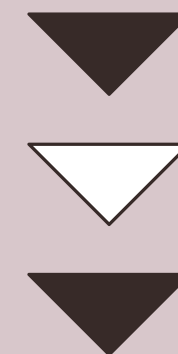
Through film and art, we tell the stories that heal wounds. Culture does not ask for passports or permissions—it flows freely, reaching hearts where politics cannot."

These acts are not entertainment—they are peace in action."



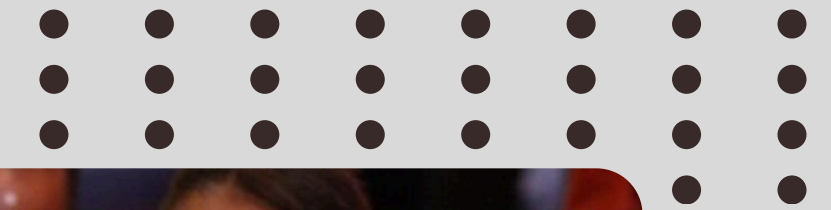

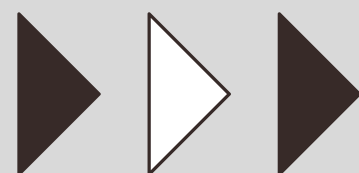


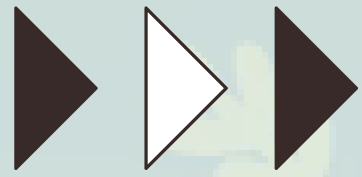
EMPOWERING YOUTH



"If we wish to see peace, we must give youth more than slogans—we must give them spaces to express, platforms to lead, and trust in their voices.

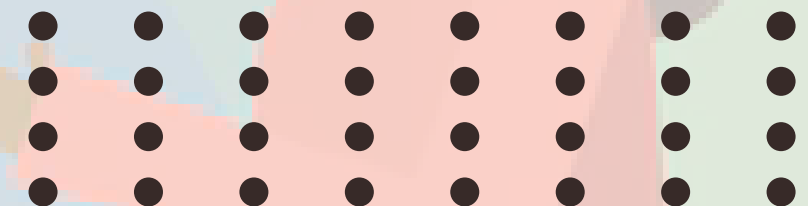
A silenced youth is a wasted future. But an empowered youth? That is the heartbeat of lasting peace."

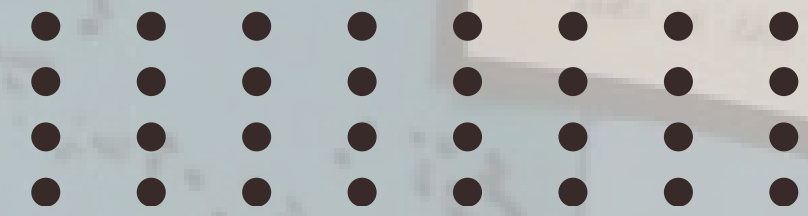


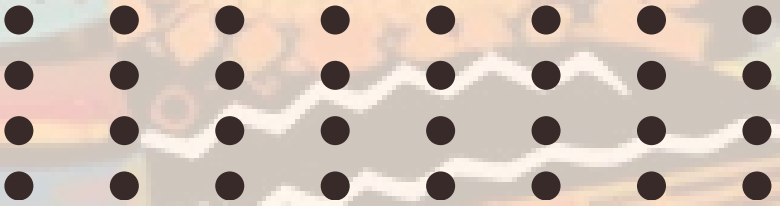


CONCLUSION

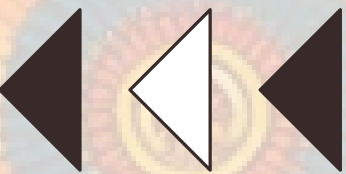
